

EMT (Out-of-County) Over 24 Months of Expiration (date on EMT card)

EFFECTIVE June 19, 2014

As an EMT certifying authority, the Kern County EMS Division re-certifies individuals who possess a current EMT card issued by an EMS agency within California or the National Registry of EMTs. EMT re-certification may be done up to six months before expiration. Re-certification documentation may be mailed or brought in to our office.

Required Continuing Education (CE) hours and Skills Verification:

Complete an entire State approved EMT course & comply with the requirements for EMT Certification

ALL ITEMS BELOW MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE CERTIFICATION CAN BE COMPLETED:

- Copy of the applicant's government issued photo identification (may be current state driver's license or identification, federally issued passport, or similar photo identification)
- Copy of expired EMT Card
- Complete an entire State approved EMT course & comply with the requirements for EMT Certification**
- DOJ and FBI Live Scan Background Check (If not already completed)
