

Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) Certification

EFFECTIVE June 19, 2014

The Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) Certification program is an eight (8) hour training program for California Registered Nurses with valid ACLS certifications that are interested in obtaining Kern County MICN certification. The course of instruction is designed to provide students with the necessary information to competently function as an MICN in Kern County.

This course includes a thorough overview of the Kern County EMS system. Topics discussed include: State EMS Systems, Kern County EMS Division, medical control and quality improvement strategy, EMT-I and Paramedic Scope of Practice, detailed education in Paramedic Treatment Protocols, Kern County Medical Communications System, Kern County Med-Alert System, biomedical communication principles, and MICN/Paramedic ALS communication scenarios.

The course is concluded with the MICN certification examination. Upon completion of 16 hours of paramedic ambulance ride time, four ALS level communication cases under the supervision of a certified MICN, and completion of basic MICN certification application requirements, the individual is certified as an MICN for Kern County. Eight (8) BRN continuing education contact hours are issued for completion.
