

Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) Re-certification

EFFECTIVE June 19, 2014

The Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) Re-certification program is a four (4) hour training program for MICN personnel in need of re-certification. The course of instruction is designed to provide students with progressive education regarding MICN practices and local EMS System changes within Kern County.

The course provides a detailed overview of the current status and future objectives of the EMS system, Paramedic Scope of Practice/Protocol changes and trends, progressive information related to EMS system quality assurance, Kern County Medical Communications System, and Kern County Med-Alert System.

The course is concluded with the MICN certification examination. Upon completion and meeting basic MICN re-certification application requirements, the individual will receive another MICN certification card which is valid for two years. Four (4) BRN continuing education contact hours are issued for completion.

The following items are **REQUIRED TO BE ELIGIBLE** for MICN re-certification:
