COURSE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Participants will have basic knowledge of the anatomy and physiology of the eye.
- Participants will be able to demonstrate proper screening techniques for visual acuity and for the detection of amblyopia in children.
- Participants will become aware of specific ophthalmologic problems influencing visual performance and understand appropriate action, referral, and follow up.
- Participants will become familiar with CHDP Health Assessment Guidelines (HAG) as related to vision screenings and will be able to document screening findings appropriately.

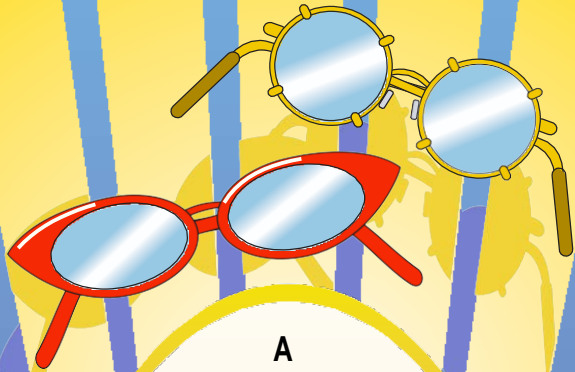

CHDP REQUIREMENTS

CHDP requires vision screening of all children. Beginning at age 3, vision testing should be attempted.

CHDP pays for a re-check if there are questionable results.

CHDP REFERRAL CRITERIA

- Any eye condition
- Problem(s) from history or observation
- Problem(s) detected from Hirschberg, red reflex or cover tests
- 20/50 or worse either eye for 3 to 5 years old
- 20/40 or worse either eye for 6 years old and up
- Two line difference in visual acuity between the eyes
