## CHDP REQUIREMENTS

CHDP requires vision screening of all children. Beginning at age 3, vision testing should be attempted.

CHDP pays for a re-check if there are questionable results.

## CHDP REFERRAL CRITERIA

- Any eye condition
- Problem(s) from history or observation
- Problem(s) detected from Hirschberg, red reflex or cover tests
- 20/50 for 3 years old and up
- 20/40 for 4 years old and up
- 20/30 for 5 years old and up
- Two line difference in visual acuity between the eyes

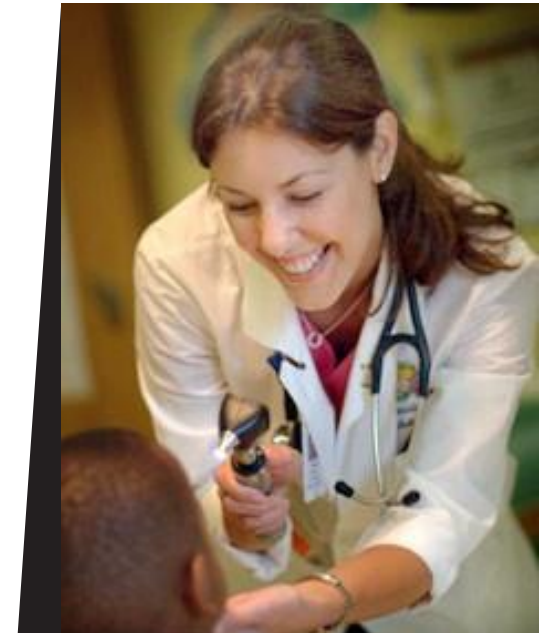
