

## **In-County EMT Initial Certification**

**EFFECTIVE July 1, 2017**

**In-County** status refers to an EMT who lives in Kern County or is, at the time of certification, employed by an approved Kern County EMT provider.

To be certified as an EMT, all individuals must submit documentation and fees listed below. Once EMT certification requirements are met, the individual will receive an EMT certification card that is valid throughout the State of California.

### **ALL ITEMS BELOW MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE CERTIFICATION CAN BE COMPLETED:**

- Copy of the applicant's government issued photo identification (may be current state driver's license or identification, federally issued passport, or similar photo identification)
- Copy of the applicant's current CPR card
- Copy of 8 ½" x 11" NATIONAL REGISTRY EMT-BASIC CERTIFICATE from the NREMT –OR-  
Copy of EMT- Basic National Registry card
- DOJ and FBI Live Scan Background Check
