## **Kern County Remains in the Orange Tier**

Today the State will announce that Kern County remains in the Orange Tier (Tier 3) of the COVID-19 Blueprint for a Safer Economy. This marks the fifth week our county has been in the Orange Tier.

Every county is assigned to one of four tiers based on the adjusted case rate, testing positivity rate, and health equity metric. Below is a summary of Kern County's current metrics and a comparison of Kern's metrics last week:

Kern must meet the Yellow Tier metrics for at least two consecutive weeks to be able to progress forward, so the earliest Kern could be eligible to move into the Yellow Tier is May 26.

We are starting to see slight increases in COVID disease transmission and hospitalization in Kern County and we continue to see our vaccination rates decline. Stopping this pandemic requires using all of the tools that we have available, including distancing, masking, and most importantly getting vaccinated.

Yesterday the FDA authorized the Pfizer vaccine for 12 to 15-year olds. The next step in this process is for CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) to review and provide a recommendation. They are expected to meet tomorrow morning. We await the final recommendations from these groups prior to informing our local providers to proceed in administration to this new age group.

Vaccination remains the safest and quickest way to immunity and those 16 and older are encouraged to get the COVID-19 vaccine. The Public Health COVID-19 vaccine nurse hotline is available from 7AM to 7PM, seven days a week. Call or text 661-677-4177 to ask your vaccine related questions.

The Kern County Fairgrounds Mass Vaccination Clinic offers Pfizer vaccine from the comfort of your car. The clinic operates Wednesday thru Sunday, 9:30am to 4pm.
