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Monkeypox Employer Exposure Guidance

Suspected Monkeypox Exposure Close Contact

- 1. Identify all persons who have been within 6 feet of Suspected/Confirmed Case for 3 hours or more in a 24-hour without a surgical mask period during infectious period.
- 2. Identify all persons who may have been in direct physical contact with Suspected Case during infectious period.
- 3. Notify all Exposed Persons of their potential exposure, including dates of potential exposure.
- 4. Recommend Exposed Persons contact their healthcare provider for assessment of post-exposure prophylaxis.
- 5. Exposed persons without symptoms do not need to be excluded from work.
- 6. Exposed persons should monitor for symptoms for 21 days after last exposure and immediately leave work if symptoms occur.
- 7. Exposed persons should contact their healthcare provider if symptoms develop and notify healthcare provider that they may have been exposed to a person with monkeypox.

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
