



## **Monkeypox Employer Exposure Guidance**

### **Suspected Monkeypox Exposure Close Contact**

1. Identify all persons who have been within 6 feet of Suspected/Confirmed Case for 3 hours or more in a 24-hour without a surgical mask period during infectious period.
2. Identify all persons who may have been in direct physical contact with Suspected Case during infectious period.
3. Notify all Exposed Persons of their potential exposure, including dates of potential exposure.
4. Recommend Exposed Persons contact their healthcare provider for assessment of post-exposure prophylaxis.
5. Exposed persons without symptoms do not need to be excluded from work.
6. Exposed persons should monitor for symptoms for 21 days after last exposure and immediately leave work if symptoms occur.
7. Exposed persons should contact their healthcare provider if symptoms develop and notify healthcare provider that they may have been exposed to a person with monkeypox.
