PUMPER VEHICLE ANNUAL HEALTH PERMIT REGISTRATION RENEWAL PROCESS INSTRUCTIONS

Online:

1. Access the Kern County Environmental Health Division website by going to <https://kernpublichealth.com/pumpers/>;
2. Click on the “**Sewage/Grease /Toilet Vehicle Update Login**” link, in blue located directly below the Headline “**Septic Pumper/Grease Pumper/Toilet Pumper**”;
3. Login using the Owner ID and Password assigned to you, located in the top right corner of the letter (or contact Environmental Health if not known);
4. Upon login, a list of all your vehicles will be available for updating;
5. You will be able to update facility contact information, add or remove waste disposal sites and add counties your business is permitted to operate in;
6. All sections and vehicles must be reviewed and **saved** prior to submittal;
7. ***Important* Before your information may be submitted for review, press the **No Change Proceed** button or **Save** button under the **Edit Facility Info** link;**
8. Once you have reviewed your information and made any necessary changes, press the **Submit Facility** button to complete the process;

Submitting Supporting Documents:

The online option to update contact and vehicle information is available all year. The “**Amended Health Permit Application**” must be completed and submitted for **changes** in the “**Vehicle Storage Yard**”, “**Disposal Site Location**” and **Vehicle Information**”. The application can be found at the Environmental Health Division website <https://kernpublichealth.com/pumpers/>.

California Department Food and Agriculture (CDFA) Inedible Kitchen Grease Hauler Permits, are required to be submitted annually. This may be done by mail, fax, or e-mail.
